Tuition Fees

The fees for 2013/14 have not yet been set but the previous year's fees should be used as a guide until they are published. In 2012/13 fees for full time UK and EU students studying for most postgraduate taught degrees or graduate diplomas were £5,000. The standard postgraduate research course fee for 2012/13 entry was £3,828.
