Living Expenses:

£625 per month or £7,500 per annum minimum. This amount is based on the needs of an unmarried student living in external accommodation. For married students substantial additional expenses will be necessary. If students bring a wife or husband they should allow at least an extra £1,500 per annum. In addition they should allow at least £650 per annum for each child.

- These costs exclude return travel from the home country and to the United Kingdom and also exclude the costs of any medical insurance students may wish to have.
- Research students should allow an additional sum of approximately £450 over the length of the course for thesis presentation, books, travel etc.

Fee Payment

You can arrange for your tuition fees to be paid by instalments, or by credit card. Further details on payment options will be given to you with your invoice, once you have registered.

Home (UK), EU & Research Students:

Our offer is subject to receipt of a completed acceptance form and acknowledgement that you have full knowledge of the costs of the course of study and living expenses and can support yourself financially during your year(s) of study or evidence that you are in receipt of a scholarship. Without these the School will be unable to complete your formal registration as a student in September.

International Taught Students:

Please arrange for your deposit payment or evidence that you are in receipt of a full scholarship, to be returned by July 31st. Without these the School will be unable to complete your formal registration as a student in September.

All NEW international students will be GUARANTEED a room in University accommodation as long as they have completed the following:

- Accepted our offer of a place on a postgraduate course
- Paid the required deposit by the deadline
