

### **The Simon Wharmby Postgraduate Scholarship in Environmental Sciences**

1. There shall be a Scholarship to be known as the Simon Wharmby Postgraduate Scholarship in Environmental Sciences. The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage a student to study any postgraduate taught programme offered by the School of Environmental Sciences.
2. The value of the Scholarship shall be £3,000.
3. The Scholarship shall be awarded on a competitive basis and will become payable on completion of registration of the successful applicant.
4. Details of the Scholarship will be publicised to all eligible students with appropriate information on selection criteria, application timescales and value of award.
5. The Scholarship will be awarded by the Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Academic) on the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising the Associate Deans for Admissions, for Research and for Learning, Teaching and Quality in the Faculty of Science.
6. If two candidates are judged to be of sufficient and equal merit, the prize may be divided. There shall be a maximum of two winners.
7. If no candidate is judged to be of sufficient merit, the prize shall not be awarded.
8. The winning candidate(s) shall be required to attend an event for publicity purposes.
