Description:

40 weekly parts bound together in one volume celebrate the world exposition of 1889.

A comprehensive guide to the exposition, it contains text, detailed illustrations and includes plans.

The exposition was held from 6 May – 31 Oct in Paris. The 1889 fair was built on the Champs de Mars, and covered 1km². This was the same site as the earlier Paris Universal Exhibition of 1867, and would later become the site for the 1900 exposition. The main symbol of the fair was the Eiffel Tower (still incomplete). The tower provided an arch and main entrance to the fair and visitors were allowed up to the second floor. It was completed later in the same year.

Conservation:

This special collections item has undergone a complete makeover by specialist binders. It was taken down into loose folios and each page was lightly numbered; the text block was deacidified with a spray; it was tissue lined and repaired using archival heat set tissue; re-collated and re-sewn all through the centre folds; some of the pages were laminated using archival heat set tissue; and finally the boards were re-backed with a new leather spine and the original spine remounted. The leaves are edged in gold.
