

Library Helpsheet: SFX

If you are searching a Library database, Primo OneSearch or Google Scholar* for electronic journal articles you can quickly check that UEA Library subscribes to the full text of the resources you find.

The Library uses software called SFX to help you link from your search results to the full text of electronic journal articles (or ebooks) where the Library has a subscription.

SFX linking also helps you quickly check if the Library has the book or journal in paper copy, and if the library doesn't subscribe to the resource you've found SFX will also give you options to check other UK Libraries (useful if you want to request an interlibrary loan).

To use SFX, click on the link that appears in your search results, or the logo:



After clicking on the SFX link, the SFX menu will open:

SFX is available on and off-campus. You will be prompted to login to subscription resources if off-campus, and occasionally on campus.

*SFX linking appears automatically when using Google Scholar on campus. To use SFX with Scholar off-campus, go to 'Scholar preferences' on the Google site and select UEA from the Library Links section.
