**Announcing the creation of two full scholarships valued at £10,950 each for September 2010.**

The University of East Anglia and INTO University of East Anglia, London invites applications for the UEA London Science Foundation Scholarships. The scholarships have been created to assist international fee-paying students, who need to complete a Foundation programme before enrolling on an undergraduate degree programme at the University of East Anglia in Norwich.

## Scholarship Details

<b>Award title</b>	UEA London Science Foundation Scholarship
<b>Number of awards</b>	2 awards in total both available for the September intake.
<b>Who is eligible?</b>	All international fee-paying students. Students who have completed 12 years of schooling (or the local equivalent to meet the same standard) with good grades. Students must have a minimum English language proficiency equivalent to IELTS 5.0 (with a minimum of 4.5 in each subskill) or equivalent. Students must be a minimum of 17 years old. Scholarships will be awarded on academic merit and the quality of the scholarship statement.
<b>General information</b>	Successful applicants will be asked to sign a formal letter agreeing to the terms and conditions of the scholarships. They will then receive a

scholarship worth £5475.00 which will be deducted from their INTO Foundation programme tuition fees.

Upon successful completion (and subject to achieving specified grades for entry), students entering degree programmes within the Faculty of Science at the University of East Anglia's campus in Norwich will receive a further £5475.00 (which will be deducted from the University's Year 1 tuition fees).

**Application procedures**

Complete an INTO University of East Anglia, London Application form stating which Foundation programme you would like to apply for. The completed form should be returned to INTO Admissions along with copies of your academic transcripts and evidence of current English language level.

Complete the UEA London Science Foundation Scholarship application form including a personal statement explaining why you want to study at the University of East Anglia and how the degree programme will help you in the future. The statement must be hand-written in English and be no more than 200 words.

**September 2010 intake**

The deadline is **Friday 06 August 2010**. All scholarships applications received by this date will be considered and the remaining 2 scholarships will be awarded. Successful candidates will be notified by Friday 13 August 2010.

\* Successful scholarship applicants who have paid their full tuition fees before 28 August 2010 will receive a scholarship of 50% of the Foundation tuition fees received. The same amount will be discounted from the first year of their undergraduate degree course at the University of East Anglia.
