Funded Pilot Programme**


Thank you for expressing interest in the funded pilot of the Postgraduate Diploma in General Pharmacy Practice (Community Pharmacy) at the University of East Anglia. I am enclosing further details about the diploma programme and information relating to the application process.

Due to the expected high level of demand for places on this programme, we cannot guarantee that all those who apply will be accepted. As this is a pilot programme, we will be aiming to recruit a cohort of pharmacists which reflects community pharmacy in the eastern region, and will therefore select from the stage 1 applications according to criteria determined by the project's steering committee. Successful applicants will be asked to complete Stage 2, the formal University application process. Applicants who are unsuccessful may be contacted in the future to participate in the evaluation of this pilot.

If you wish to apply for a funded place on this pilot programme, please complete all documents relating to Stage 1 of the application process and send them to me at the above address by 1st April 2010. We will let you know by 16th April 2010 whether or not your application has been successful.
