Study skills boot camp

Prepare your students for the transition to university. We will show them how to write an essay, how to read and research effectively, and how to manage independent study time.

Guest lectures

🕒 45-60 minutes

Get inspired and find out what students actually do at uni with a guest lecture from a UEA academic. We offer sessions covering subjects from STEM to Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities and Medicine and Health Sciences. This is a great way for your students to get a taste of university teaching, without leaving their classroom.

All our talks finish with a Q&A session where students can ask that burning question.


