

FAQ's

Who can enter?

Second year undergraduate Arts and Humanities students.

Can I enter as part of a group?

Yes, but no more than three people per group. However, if the prize is won by a group, the prize money will be equally divided with the students in the group.

How can work be submitted?

Work can be submitted in any format and entrants can be as creative as they like. Some examples of work and how they can be submitted are below:

- Photographs – electronic photographs should be emailed to artsandhumanitiesevents@uea.ac.uk. Physical photographs should be sent to Arts and Humanities Events Office, Arts 3.03, University of East Anglia, Norwich Research Park, Norwich, NR4 7TJ
- 3D work – should be filmed and sent via email or We Transfer to artsandhumanitiesevents@uea.ac.uk or by disk at the postal address above
- Written work should be emailed to artsandhumanitiesevents@uea.ac.uk. For essays, the word count is between 1,000 and 2000 words. For short-stories, the word count is 1000.
- A short film, play or audio piece should be recorded and sent to artsandhumanitiesevents@uea.ac.uk or by disk at the postal address above. They should be between 3 and 5 minutes in duration.

Who will be judging the competition?

The competition will be judged by an interdisciplinary panel chaired by the Faculty Dean of Arts and Humanities, Professor Yvonne Tasker.

I've missed the deadline. Can I still enter?

No. All entrants will need to be received on or before 12 noon on Friday 16 March 2018.

What will the winner receive?

The winner will receive a cash prize of £500. There will be three runner-up prizes of £50 each. If the prize is won by a group, the prize money will be equally divided between the students in the group.

Winning entries may be featured in the university magazine Ziggurat, the university newspaper Concrete, and on the Faculty web pages.

When is the awards ceremony?

The awards ceremony will take place on campus in the first week of term in September 2018 at the HUM showcase/transition event (exact date TBC).
