

## UEA Award Employer Panel

### What is the UEA Award Employer Panel?

The UEA Award Employer Panel is primarily virtual and consists of a wide range of employers; from small and medium sized enterprises, to large and multinational employers from all sectors including public, private and the voluntary sector. The aim of the panel is to enable employer engagement with the development of the UEA Award to ensure the skills and attributes developed by participating students continue to meet the needs of employers and to facilitate openings for employers to provide feedback and opportunities to students registered with the Award.

The Employer Panel has a broad remit, and includes the following activities:

- Providing student feedback for the Silver Award – reviewing CVs and videos;
- Providing student feedback for the Gold Award – asking questions and providing comments on face-to-face student presentations and CVs;
- Proposing new employer members of the UEA Award Steering Group;
- Acting as a consultative panel for discussions on the development of the UEA Award;
- Attending, if available, annual UEA Award Ceremonies;
- Providing, as appropriate, various opportunities and work-related activities for participating students to engage with.

### Commitment

We recognise that your time is precious and therefore have developed the engagement opportunities to be as efficient and flexible as possible. For example, in providing student feedback for the Silver Award employers would be sent batches of up to six submissions (1 CV and video per submission) no more than three times a year, spread over the course of the academic year. The UEA Award team would endeavour to give a minimum of two weeks' notice of upcoming activities.
