

Applicant Day - Tour Guides

Please sign in at Congregation Hall at 9.00am – you will sign in and collect your clothes and lanyards for the day. We will brief you on your role.

Go to the main hall in Congregation Hall and chat to visitors and stand by appropriate flag.

How to get to different accommodation

Britten, Paston, Colman or Victory House – head to the gazebo outside Nelson Court. There will be a Student Guide there to let you know which flat you can visit.

Nelson Court or Constable Terrace - head to the gazebo outside Nelson Court. There will be a Student Guide there to let you know whether you can visit Nelson Court or whether you will have to go down to Constable Terrace. If you do end up going to Constable Terrace, there will be a Student Guide based at an accommodation flag outside the block; head to the flag to find out which flat you can visit in Constable Terrace.

Hickling/Barton – head to the gazebo in between the buildings, near the laundrette. There will be a Student Guide there to let you know which flat to visit

Standard Ziggurat – head to the gazebo outside Student Support Services and Unio. There will be a Student Guide there to let you know which Norfolk or Suffolk Terrace flat to visit

Village – head to the flag in the Village between Courtyard A and Courtyard B. There will be a Student Guide there to let you know which flat you can visit.
