- An audition (approximately 10 minutes), where you will be required to perform **two contrasting pieces of your own choice, totalling no more than 10 minutes**. We may give you a short test, such as sight reading or preparing an excerpt, at short notice, before your audition. An accompaniment will be provided, if required.
