LEARNING ACTIVITIES

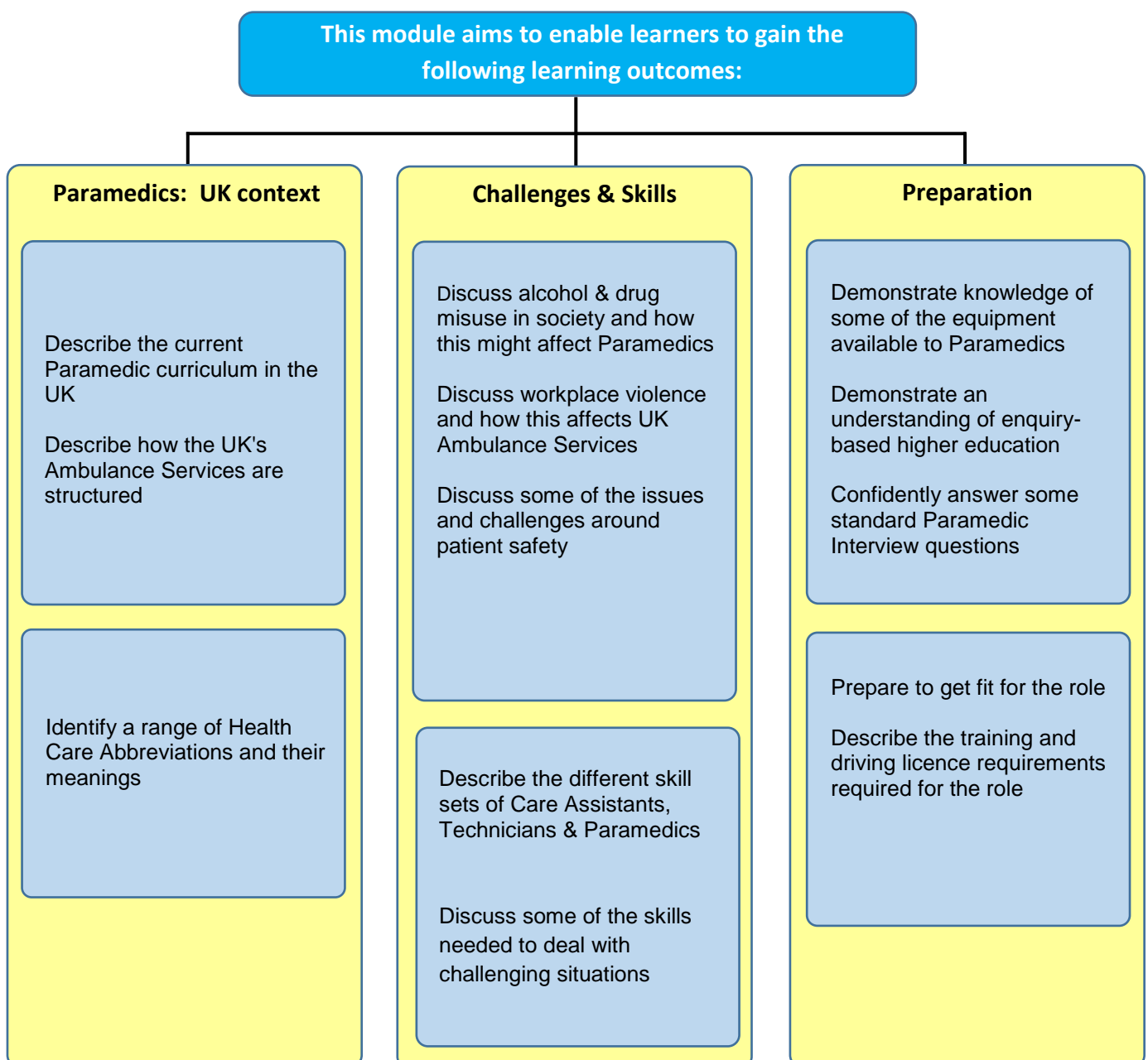
The course will be delivered via Health Online, the UEA's virtual learning environment. You will be expected to engage fully with the course material including the learning activities and interaction opportunities.

COURSE STRUCTURE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES
